

Article 2

Nonprofit Purposes

Section 1. IRC Section 501(c)(3) Purposes

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 2. Specific Objectives and Purposes

The specific objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be:

- a. To reach out to the families of gifted children needing support and to connect them with the appropriate resources.
- b. To share information with regard to the education and parenting of gifted students by offering informative programs and guest speakers at regularly held support group meetings and by advising participants of upcoming seminars, workshops, and conferences at the local, state, and national levels.
- c. To solicit support for gifted children from local and state policy makers and interested community organizations, businesses, and industries.
- d. To enhance awareness of educational issues facing gifted children and their families through public education.
- e. To promote educational opportunities for our gifted students by working with families, educators, and school administrators to implement, expand, or refine appropriately advanced programs of instruction.
- f. To establish and moderate communication networks to disseminate information, provide an arena of support and feedback, and encourage overall communication among parents and educators of gifted students and interested community members.
- g. To organize and/or provide social and enrichment opportunities for gifted students that will encourage intellectual, social, and emotional development.
- h. To engage in other activities related to the needs of gifted students and their families in our community.
